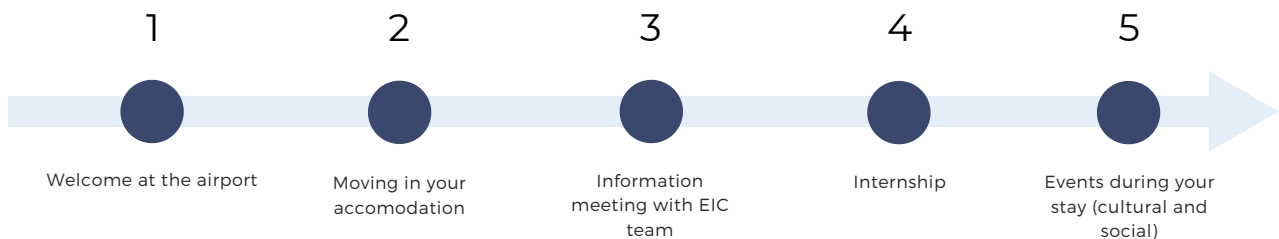

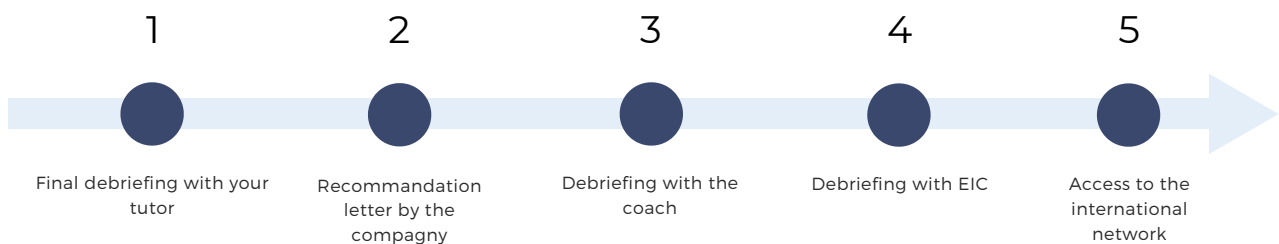

INTERNSHIP PROGRAM FEES

If your application is accepted after the interview, you will receive an admission notification. **Within 14 days of notification, you can confirm your place on our program by paying a deposit of €450.** This is fully refundable if the internship offer does not meet the expectations specified at the time of registration, or if you change your mind and wish to withdraw from the program.

Once you have submitted your application, our teams will meet with you to establish your profile and expectations of the internship. You will then meet with the companies and receive notification of your internship location shortly afterwards. We will then propose an internship contract for you to sign. **You will have up to 21 days before the start date of the internship to pay the remaining fees** (mentioned in the internship contract) - **payment in instalments** is possible, please contact our team.

Finally, the administrative management of your file can begin: visa application, internship agreement, scholarships applications, purchase of airfare, etc.

Prices for the all-inclusive package vary according to the length of the internship, the destination and the type of accommodation selected (see table below). **The price of the simple package is set at €2,850, whatever the duration of the internship and the destination.**

VISA ASSISTANCE

To carry out an internship in Canada, you need an open or closed work permit. This can be difficult to organize from a legal and administrative perspective. Without assistance, obtaining a Canadian work visa can be difficult. We have teams dedicated to support you through the process.

Our participants are eligible for two types of work visa: the Stage Coop visa and the Work and Holiday Permit (WHP). Both visas require you to start the process as soon as possible: at least three months for a Stage Coop and at least one year for a WHP.



****Please note that Canada's immigration authority, Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC), has the final say on who is admitted each year. All accepted participants have an equal chance of obtaining this visa, but the group of trainees is also subject to the rules and decisions made by IRCC. If program participants are unsuccessful in obtaining a visa in the year they apply, they will have the option of deferring their participation to the following year or obtaining a full refund. ****

VISA ASSISTANCE

The main visa requested by our participants is the Stage Coop visa. It is easier to obtain than a WHP. If we accept your application, you will need to start the visa application process immediately after notification of acceptance. The visa application is made online and costs CAD\$160. Processing times vary according to the applicant and the date of application. The visa is valid for the duration of the internship (maximum 12 months).

Eligibility criteria to the Stage Coop visa:

- You must be a citizen of one of the countries with which Canada has an agreement
- You must be between 18 and 35
- Your passport must be valid for the duration of your internship.
- You must have a clean criminal record (verification may be requested).
- You must have medical insurance to cover your stay in Canada.
- You must have proof of funds equal to or greater than CAD\$2,500.

Stretching from the Pacific to the Atlantic Ocean, Canada is the world's second-largest country, with ten provinces and three territories. The country's capital is Ottawa.

Canada is one of the world's top ten trading nations. Its highly globalized economy is based on three metropolises: Montreal, Toronto and Vancouver. Toronto and Montreal are major financial centers in North America.

Canada is a founding member of the United Nations, and a member of the WTO, G20, G7 and OECD. The country is also a member of other international organizations, and participates in international and regional forums on economic and cultural affairs.

Multiculturalism in the land of the maple syrup is a distinctive element of the Canadian identity. Canada is a mosaic of indigenous and regional ethnic cultures. English and French are the official languages. The country is considered one of the most pleasant to live in, thanks to its excellent quality of life.

THE CITIES OF OUR PROGRAM

MONTREAL

Montreal is Quebec's metropolis. Located in the southwest of the province, the city has a continental climate, with hot summers and cold, snowy winters. It's a polyglot city, with French and English as its main languages.

The city is a major commercial, financial, industrial and technological center. Montreal industries include aerospace, electronics, artificial intelligence, gaming and transportation. Montreal is home to the head offices of numerous companies.

Montreal is also a major cultural center, with numerous music and film festivals. The city hosted the Olympic Games (summer 1976) and the Exposition Universelle (1967).

With four universities and seven other post-secondary institutions, Montreal has a very active student life, with many meeting places and exchanges.



TORONTO

Toronto is Canada's largest city. Its continental climate means hot summers and cold winters. English is the main language of Torontonians, and its cosmopolitanism makes it one of the most diverse cities in the world.

The city is the country's main economic center. The Toronto Stock Exchange is North America's second-largest financial center. Five Canadian banks are headquartered in Toronto, as are many other major Canadian corporations. Its economy is based on technology, design, financial services, life sciences and the environment.

Toronto is also a leading center for culture. The city abounds in museums, art galleries, creative venues and festivals of international stature. Sports are very popular. Millions of tourists flock to Toronto every year.



THE CITIES OF OUR PROGRAM

VANCOUVER

As British Columbia's largest city, Canada's third-largest metropolis and a port city in Western Canada, Vancouver has the highest population density in Canada. The climate is temperate. Although English is the main language, the majority of its inhabitants do not have English as their mother tongue.

Vancouver is a prosperous city on the Pacific coast, with an economy based primarily on industry. Vancouver is the headquarters of mining and forest products companies. It is a centre for software development, biotechnology, aerospace products, video games and film and television production.

The city is popular for the vast landscapes that surround it, representing a window on Canadian nature. Nature is also present in the city, with numerous gardens and parks dotting the streets. It's a perfect showcase for the healthy lifestyle.



OTTAWA

The country's capital is located in the east of the country. The climate is continental, with hot summers and cold winters. Federal institutions include Parliament, the Governor General's residence and the Prime Minister's residence. English is the city's main language, but there are many French speakers in the capital.

The activities of government departments and agencies, high technology, health and tourism are the backbone of Ottawa's economy. National Defence Headquarters in Ottawa is the main command center for the Canadian Armed Forces, and home to the Department of National Defence.

Ottawa is also home to several museums, including the National Gallery of Canada, the Canadian Museum of Nature and the Canadian War Museum.



THE CITIES OF OUR PROGRAM

QUEBEC CITY

Quebec City is the capital of the Canadian province of Quebec. The climate is classified as humid continental. The city's main language is French.

Quebec City's economy is concentrated in public administration, finance, insurance, services and healthcare. Numerous head offices of leading companies are located in Quebec City.

Quebec City is one of the oldest European cities in North America. Two monuments are emblematic of the city: the Château Frontenac and the Citadelle of Quebec. Old Quebec is home to the Quebec National Assembly, the Musée national des Beaux-Arts du Québec and the Musée de la civilisation.



CALGARY

Calgary is the largest city in the Canadian province of Alberta. It is located in the southern part of the province, in a hilly region. The climate is continental, with long, but highly variable winters and short, hot summers.

Calgary's economy is essentially based on the oil industry, although agriculture, tourism and high technology are other sectors of its economic development. Many major oil and gas companies are headquartered here, and many financial services companies have grown up around them.

Calgary is a well-known destination for winter sports and ecotourism, with many major resorts located close to the city. Calgary also hosts several major annual festivals.

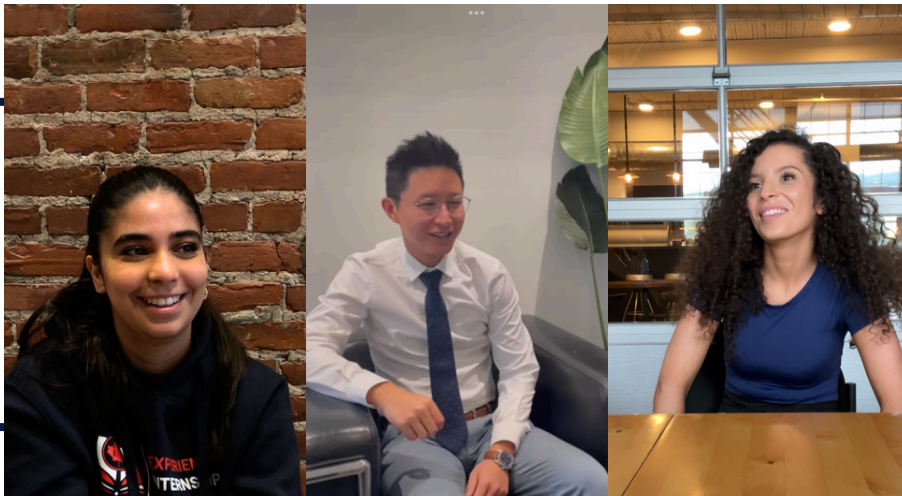

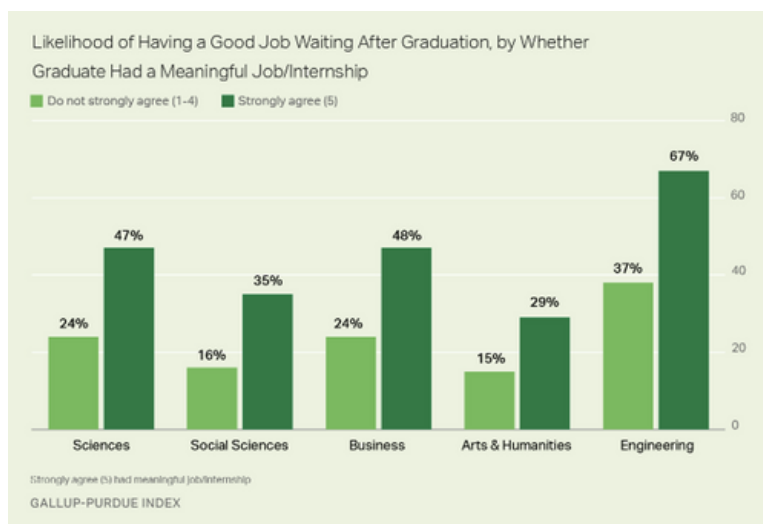
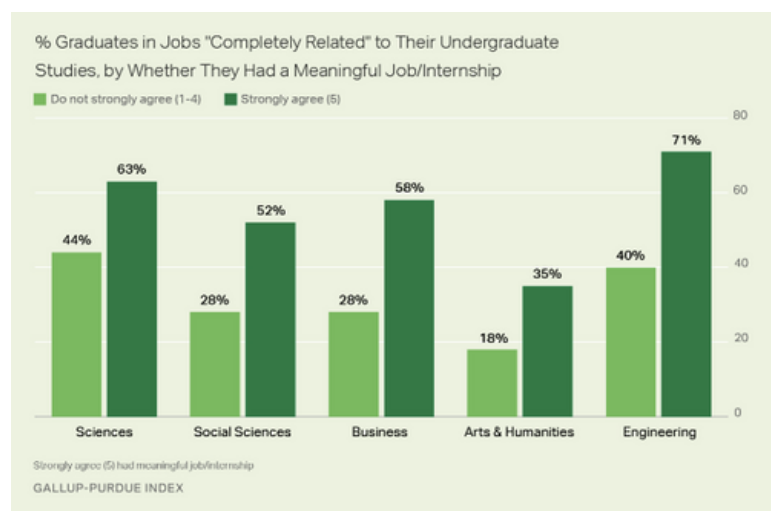

FINANCIAL RESSOURCES

SCHOLARSHIPS

There are many scholarships available to finance an internship in Canada:

- Local authorities can grant scholarships to students.
- Private foundations also offer internship scholarships.
- Depending on the field of study, there are specific scholarships available.

Most scholarships are cumulative and can amount to thousands of euros. The Wizbii platform will tell you which scholarships you are eligible for.

COMPENSATION

Internship compensation in Canada is unregulated and varies according to sector, company and position. Remuneration can take the form of a salary, performance-related commissions or company-specific benefits. Bear in mind, however, that an internship in finance or accounting is much more likely to result in financial compensation than an internship with an association or NGO, for example.

FINANCING PLAN

There are lots of financing programs available for students. We have access to many financial partners and can recommend them to you. We also suggest you get in touch with your bank.

1. WHAT IS THE PLACEMENT WARRANTY?

The placement warranty is our assurance to find you the expectations-meeting internship. If your application does not match with our companies, we will fully refund your deposit.

2. ARE THE INTERSHIPS PAID?

Internship compensation in Canada is unregulated and varies according to sector, company and position. Remuneration can take the form of a salary, performance-related commissions or company-specific benefits. If you do not need any accommodation, you can choose the simple package of internship in Canada. For more information, please contact our team.

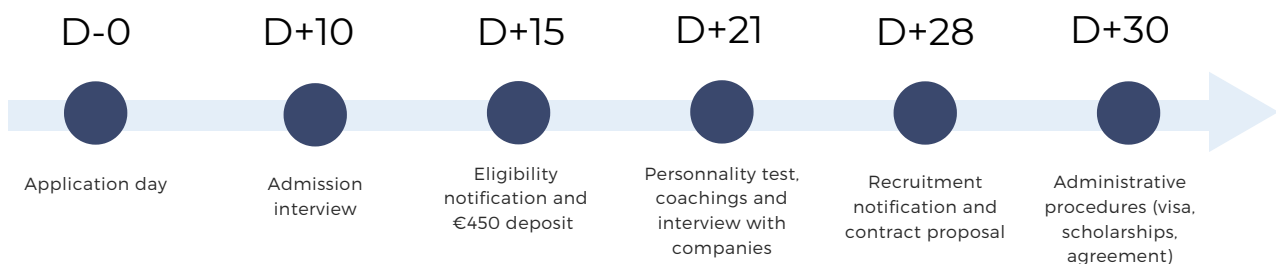
8. WHAT IS THE REFUND OR CANCELLATION POLICY?

We understand that your plans can change. That is why we offer, at any time, a lifetime credit for any our programs. This means that if you want to delay your participation to the program or change the destination, all already paid fees will be transferred to your new choice. Do not forget that the fees of the program can change anytime; applicants are subjected to in effect fees when submitting their new application. Credit can be transferred to direct family, exclusively.

9. WHAT IS THE DEADLINE TO APPLY?

We recruit interns on a continuous basis; you can submit your application at any moment. We recommend to apply as quickly as possible ; indeed, obtaining the visa can take a long time. To work in Canada, even as an intern, you need a work permit. Ideally, you will start the process three months before the desired start date.

11. WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF AN INTERNSHIP IN CANADA? WHY SHOULD I JOIN THIS PROGRAM?

An internship is the opportunity to put into practice the theoretical knowledge previously learned. You will be fulfilled in new environments and will be in contact with people from all walks in life.

12. CAN I CONSULT A LIST OF EMPLOYERS OR CHOOSE A SPECIFIC COMPANY TO DO MY INTERNSHIP IN?

We work with a lot of companies in Canada. We do not have a fixed list of partner companies. The internships we offer depend on the availability of the jobs. We cannot then guarantee a specific company.

13.WHAT HAPPENS IF I DO NOT GET THE INTERSHIP THAT I WISH FOR?

We are proud of the twinnings between our participants and our partner companies. We guarantee you an internship in your predilection field. If we do not succeed, you can assert the placement warranty or the lifetime credit.

14.CAN I TALK TO THE DESTINATION TEAMS BEFORE BEING ACCEPTED OR CONFIRM MY PLACE IN THE PROGRAM?

Due to the high volume of applications, our teams can only work with applicants who have officialy confirmed their place in the program.



15.WHAT ARE THE WORKING HOURS?

In Canada, the working week is 40 hours long. Most internships take place between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m.

16.WILL I GET UNIVERSITY CREDITS?

If your internship is compulsory, you'll earn university credits; to do so, you'll need to meet the validation requirements (internship report).

17. IS PARTICIPATION TO THE EVENTS MANDATORY?

All the events and activities we organize are optional. However, they are designed to help you make the most of your experience, both personally and professionally, so we advise you to attend!



18. HOW ARE THE ACCOMMODATIONS ORGANIZED?

Our accommodations include private areas (bedrooms and bathrooms) and shared areas (kitchen, library, games room). They are equipped with high-quality facilities: swimming pool, gym, laundry room, restaurants, etc.



19. CAN I LIVE IN THE HOUSING FOR A CERTAIN PERIOD OF TIME BEFORE OR AFTER MY INTERNSHIP?

We can only guarantee accommodation for the duration of your program. If you would like to take advantage of more than this, please contact our team.

20.WHEN SHOULD I BOOK MY FLIGHTS?

The sooner the better. If you can, take a flexible airfare; this will allow you to postpone your trip in the case of visa delays.

21.WHAT HAPPENS WHEN I ARRIVE AT MY DESTINATION?

Before you leave, we will send you a welcome pack to prepare for your arrival. As soon as you land, you will be taken care of by our team; our trusted driver will take you to your accommodation. There you will meet your coordinator for a tour and an introduction meeting. If you arrive at your destination after 6 p.m. local time, you will meet your coordinator the following morning.
